## Scholarship winner is mining his musical talent

Casey Messent was walking to class when he got the call to say he was the 2019 recipient of the Gordon Chesterman scholarship. Now he can continue his study and follow his dream to create music and events from the natural amphitheatre on the site of the former Huntly East Mine.

This promising musician has been writing music since the age of 12 and this was his first year, studying a Bachelor of Music and Performing Arts at Wintec.

“I was pretty stoked to say the least. It definitely made my day,” he says.

In 2019, Casey was one of the first students to enrol in the new three-year Bachelor of Performing Arts and Music degree at Wintec.

“Enrolling in this programme was the best decision I’ve ever made – it’s allowed me to be myself again.

When he isn’t studying, working part-time, performing, composing or producing music, you will find Casey helping with the rehabilitation of the Huntly East Mine.

The former coal mine was once a lake and Casey’s grandparents purchased the property.

The plan is to rehabilitate the weed-infested land into a 60-metre-deep lake with a planted walkway, and create a space for an outdoor events centre, which will eventually host mountain biking and water sports, along with festivals and shows.

They’ve already hosted several smaller music festivals there and Casey’s looking forward to providing music students the opportunity to get involved, learn from and perform in a festival environment.

## Wintec awards outstanding adult learners

Twenty-two outstanding adult students who are striving to be the best in their fields were celebrated at the 2019 Wintec Adult Learner Awards.

The six overall award winners study a diverse range of vocational qualifications including midwifery, arboriculture, commercial music, information

technology and strategic management.

Adult Learner Awards were awarded to Emma Wellwood (Midwifery), Leonard Walker (Bachelor of Media Arts (Commercial Music) and Emelia Harris (Certificate Te Ara Putake).

Nooti Waho (Certificate in Arboriculture Level 4) and Toni Smith (Bachelor of Applied Information Technology) were recognised with Māori and Pasifika Adult Learner Awards and the International Student Award went to Shamila Saldanha (Graduate Diploma in Strategic Management).

Wintec Dean and Director People and Culture Katrina Van de Ven says the awards acknowledge the challenges and sacrifices adult learners take.

“Our adult learners have returned to learning and through dedication and commitment, many achieve beyond what they ever thought possible.

“They are making an investment in their futures and as learners, they face challenges. Many have made big sacrifices, balancing time, energy, family and work commitments to keep going.”

Katrina says that unlike many school-leavers, adult students may have already experienced more of life and are clear about what they are studying and why, and they also know what they hope to achieve.

Adult students make up around 45 percent of Wintec’s student population and numbers have increased by six percent in the past five years.

## **A dream comes true! Basira thanks the Prime Minister**

Wintec language student, Basira Frotan, had a dream come true during a class trip to Fieldays near Hamilton, when she got the opportunity to thank Prime Minister, Jacinda Adern for her support of Muslims in New Zealand.

Basira, from Afghanistan, has been in New Zealand for six years. This was her first visit to Fieldays, the largest agricultural event in the Southern Hemisphere and she had no idea what

to expect. What she didn’t anticipate, was a meeting with Jacinda Adern.

Wintec Centre for Languages tutor, Karen Kemsley took Basira and her classmates along to the official opening ceremony and it was there, they happened to hear the Prime Minister speak.

Basira, who had dreamt of thanking the Prime Minister since the Christchurch shootings in March 2019, described how Jacinda’s words, “We are one” and “They are us”, had touched her heart and motivated her when she was reeling from the shock of the shootings.

At Fieldays, Basira got her opportunity when her tutor led her through the Prime Minister’s entourage, chatted briefly with the security detail and arranged for Basira to meet with the Prime Minister.

## Two Māori ‘aunties’ took carpentry class to new levels

There was a different kind of buzz going on in one of Wintec’s carpentry classes when two ‘aunties’ swapped their handbags for toolbelts.

The ‘aunties’ are Miriama Wara and Ataneta Barakat and they signed up to the Māori Trades Training scheme to learn to build. They were the only women in a class of around 20 Māori and Pasifika youth enrolled in the Māori and Pasifika Trades Training Scheme (MPTT) and they had a special kind of influence on the class.

Wintec tutor Gene Cooper smiled when he talked about the pair who he says, “put 120 percent into everything they did,” including supporting their fellow students.

“They brought a calmness to the class. They spoke up for students and the students respected them and went to them for advice. They are two amazing ladies who came here because they wanted to understand the building process from the ground up, including what products to use and the law around building consent. They added a whole new dimension to this class.”

While the younger generation in the class had careers in their sights, it was a different story for the two Waikato-Tainui women who have a plan to reconnect their whānau (wider family) with their ancestral land.

“The environment was different in this class, it’s a whānau environment, some of the students ask for advice because we’re mums and we can understand,” says Miriama.

Their course ended in November but along the way they progressed from using hand tools to create timber joints, and built a sawhorse before their final project, a simple shed.

“I’m eyeing up where I can add the toilet and shower,” said Ataneta.

Together they said the knowledge they gained, has helped them look at things differently.

## Whānau is everything for four Māori Masters graduates

Four Māori nurses graduated in 2019 with Masters degrees from Wintec and all agree that time is the biggest challenge, and a supportive network means everything.

The four, Myra Pourau (Ngāti Raukawa, Ngāti Maniapoto, Ngāi Te Rangi), Ellyn Proffit (Ngāti Porou), Janette Ngahe (Ngāti Awa, Te Pahipoto, Ngāti Pikiao), and Natalie Lewis (Ngāti Tuwharetoa, Ngāti Porou, Tainui) all value education in progressing their careers and want to inspire others to follow an academic pathway to find success.

Myra Pourau and Ellyn Proffit graduated with a Master of Nursing and Janette Ngahe and Natalie Lewis graduated with a Master of Professional Practice.

Wintec Chief Executive David Christiansen says Māori achievement is a focus at Wintec and it’s important that learners are enabled with the right tools and support to achieve success.

“Around 26 percent of Wintec students identify as Māori and we’re really proud of that. What makes us even happier is the levels of achievement our Māori students are attaining.

“Māori student success is crucial if we are to develop a workforce that reflects the diversity and the needs of our community and reduce health inequities for Māori. These four Masters graduates are great role models in this respect, particularly for those considering a career in nursing.”

# Wintec graduates create New Zealand’s largest mural

A group of mastermind Māori artists have turned a 248m long canvas in Hamilton, into New Zealand’s biggest mural. Te Whētū Collective transformed the Te Kōpū Mānia o Kirikiriroa site, also known as the Wintec wall, over several weeks in January 2020.

Three visual artists, Poihakena Ngāwati (Waikato-Tainui), Hana Maihi (Ngāti Mahana), and Te Haunui Tuna (Ngāi Tūhoe) make up the collective. Poihakena and Te Haunui are Wintec School of Media Arts graduates.

Poihākena Ngāwati, a Hamiltonian, muralist and former Wintec student, grew up and studied in close proximity to the “concrete eye-sore” and was keen to finally see it transformed. “This project will be transformational for the city both as contemporary creative expression and as a commentary on the wall’s history,” says Ngāwati.

“It is the last trace of a hill known as Te Kōpū Mānia o Kirikiriroa (the smooth belly [or womb] of Kirikiriroa),” he says. The original site was of major importance to the Waikato region serving as a hub for cultivation, learning and ceremony. The mural incorporates the Waikato River, three tui, and a female portrait depicting Matariki as the mother of the hill and master of the Māori lunar calendar and cultivation.

The piece has themes of guardianship, whakapapa, and unity woven behind the imagery.

Ngāwati says, “we wanted to tell the story of this particular hill and use the mural to acknowledge the historical wahi pa (local site), explain why it was valued and important for

surrounding tribes, and make a commentary on how we can use these learnings for our future.”

Individually, the three artists have travelled as far as Hawai’i, Rarotonga and across New Zealand painting large-scale murals. Te Kōpū Mānia o Kirikiriroa is their first work as a collective.

The project is driven by the Beyond Tomorrow Trust and Creative Waikato managed the creative process.

Te Kōpū Mānia o Kirikiriroa is also the name of Wintec’s marae, which shares the historic site.

## The secret to balancing study, a job, a baby and a life

One of the biggest challenges to students is time, especially when they are parents, and it's also one of the reasons why some students don't complete their study.

Juggling was second nature to Rotorua-based Slade King last year when he worked as a Strength and Conditioning Coach in Rotorua and Mount Maunganui while he completed a Postgraduate Diploma in Sport and Exercise Science at Wintec. Alongside two part-time jobs, study and a 2.5-hour round trip commute, he still found time for his wife and baby girl, and his own personal training schedule.

How did he do it? By segmenting his commute, study and work and doing what he loves, with an eye to the pay-off in the future, he made it work.

"Besides loving the work I do (it actually doesn't even feel like work) and what I'm studying, I enjoy changing up locations and creating wider networks as a result of my travelling and multiple responsibilities," he says.

"I don't get over any of it, because due to the nature of what I do, it's all in small doses. I believe my management and organisational skills are sharper than ever because of this workload, and I know it will benefit me in the future."

Slade says the biggest setback was having less time for his family, but he managed to work in time for that too.

This student dynamo was also coaching up to 80 rugby players for the Bay of Plenty (BOP) Rugby Union.

He says that after looking into all his options around the North Island, Wintec "was an easy choice".

"They were prompt and professional in making contact right away, they showed genuine care of the situation I was in by being as flexible and accommodating as they could, and most importantly, the quality of the course is up there with the best."

## This student has IT in her jeans

Buy one of Eunji Min's backpacks and you can track the recycled denim back to its source in New Zealand, thanks to technology developed by Wintec students.

Eunji Min was in the third year of her fashion design degree at Wintec School of Media Arts and she was looking at ways to upcycle denim jeans into bags, connect the 'owners' and encourage sustainable living. The result is the Contrisumer project.

Eunji says 'Contrisumer' is a combination of the words, 'contributor' and 'consumer' and the project's aim was to develop an app for the consumer to connect them to the contributor, or at least source the denim for her Cheong Ba. G, brand bags.

"Cheong means clean, blue, denim in Korean. Cheong ba ji also means jeans in Korean so I named my brand Cheong Ba. G."

Cheong Ba. G products are made with recycled denim sourced from friends and second-hand shops.

Her tutor, Rebekah Harman challenged the class to explore collaborations with other classes and students. Eunji's Contrisumer project is a collaboration between the design student and a tutor and students from Wintec's Centre for Information Technology who designed the Ba-G app.

Every Cheong Ba. G bag features a QR code that links to Ba-G – the Contrisumer app. The bag owner can track the denim source on a map and discover the story behind it. The app also has the potential to connect the donor and the end user (that's optional).

"This project is a great example of a design degree student working across schools and utilising different disciplines to achieve something really great," says Julie Ashby, Spatial Design Manager at Wintec School of Media Arts.

"Making it in a complex world has better possibilities when we don't stick to our knitting. We need to ask what is possible and how do we get there."

Eunji is from South Korea. After majoring in business

administration, she worked in an IT company and was also a junior teacher in Korea, before going to Ireland to study fashion in Dublin.

### Scholarship winners say strong whānau connections carry them through

The importance of whānau support and the power of this to help get students through their study was a recurring theme when two Wintec health students were awarded the Dame Te Atairangikaahu Scholarship.

Raea Bainbridge, who is studying nursing, and Andrea Joyce, a midwifery student, are the 2019 recipients. Heeni Paki, daughter of the late Te Arikiniui Dame Te Atairangikaahu presented them with their scholarships at a special event at Wintec’s Te Kōpū Mānia o Kirikiriroa Marae.

Wintec Director Māori, Hera White says the scholarship enables Waikato-Tainui people to consider a career in health and contributes to a more culturally responsive health workforce across the region.

“We chose these students because of their deep love for our people and their passion for Māori and Pasifika health and wellbeing.

“Māori student success is crucial if we are to develop a

workforce for our community and reduce health inequities. For our students, this scholarship can be the difference because not only is it an honour to receive, it will also ease the financial challenge of full-time study.”

Scholarship recipient Andrea Joyce brought tears to the eyes of many as she recounted the challenge of achieving her dream to be a midwife while raising a family and meeting the financial demands of study.

“I couldn’t have come this far without the support of my whānau and the community around me,” she said.

“Having this scholarship is going to make all the difference towards my dream of becoming a midwife.”

Raea Bainbridge, an aspiring nurse “with a big heart” stood with his whānau after receiving his scholarship. His proud and active 91-year-old grandmother was there too for her grandson. His mother recounted the ways in which Raea worked to improve the health of those around him, including his beloved Nana in their Tokoroa community.

A past recipient of the scholarship, Awhina Uruamo, now a respiratory research nurse, researcher and personal nurse to Kingi Tūheitia, shared her story with the students and whānau gathered at Wintec’s marae.

“Getting this scholarship is huge! I want to focus on the support of friends and whānau because they can be so crucial in getting you through,” she said.

“Hold on to your whānau because they keep you strong.”

Hamilton-based product development manager and Wintec engineering graduate, Huzaifa Mohsinally has a dream. He wants to improve people's lives through innovative design.

To help him on his way, he's signed up for an exclusive MIT-Harvard Medical School Healthcare Innovation Bootcamp in the United States during March this year.

Born in India, raised in Singapore and educated in New Zealand, life has certainly been a journey for Huzaifa, who believes anything is possible when you view challenges as opportunities.

"My dream is to start my own engineering and innovation company in New Zealand to deliver world-class solutions to improve people's living conditions around the world."

The Innovation Bootcamp he is attending, is a highly selective, accelerated learning programme which prepares participants to comprehensively contribute to healthcare innovation.

For Huzaifa, this is all he's ever wanted.

"This experience will expand my thought process and allow me to contribute to my current employer, DEC International NZ and hopefully guide me to build my own company in the future."

Huzaifa, now 26 years-old, was born in Mumbai and came to New Zealand when he was 19. After looking at various study options, he settled on the two-year New Zealand Diploma in Engineering (with a major in Mechanical Engineering) at Wintec. He looks back at his time here fondly.

"This course was a great entry point for me, and it was

extremely exciting. I won the Stainless Design Award for the top graduating student and my final project, which was based on a solar evacuated water heating system, also won an award."

"My studies at Wintec incorporated practical and theoretical aspects of engineering which helped me relate to things much quicker once I started working. Initially, there were quite a few things that directly related to what I'd studied."

Huzaifa is now the New Product Development Manager at DEC, responsible for managing all new design and development projects for the company.

"To be extremely honest, ever since I arrived in New Zealand, I have been able to view challenges as opportunities and make the most of them as I've gone along. Perhaps the most challenging thing for me has been believing in myself and my abilities. I want people to know that anything possible."

## 'Just say yes!' Growth outside the comfort zone for Cody

If you'd met Wintec student, Cody Steens two years ago, chances are you wouldn't have guessed that in 2019 he'd be living in China and jumping at every opportunity that came his way.

In 2017, Cody was a Design student at Wintec School of Media Arts and was not someone who enjoyed taking centre-stage.

"I was an awkward person, who didn't speak much," he says.

Cody would sit-back in group situations, and not propose ideas or put up his hand when the opportunity arose.

Last year, Cody chose to study at Design Factory NZ – Wintec's

specialised co-creation and innovation space. During the 16-week programme, he gradually began to involve himself more and more.

When the opportunity came for Design Factory NZ students to attend a design competition in Chengdu, China – Cody jumped at the chance. Over the intense week, he got his first experience of international travel, a new culture and he led his team’s presentation in front of an audience of more than 300 people.

This experience planted the growth bug firmly in Cody’s mind. When he returned, he applied for a prestigious Prime Minister’s Scholarship for Asia to attend Chengdu University. He was successful and last year he went to China to study Post-Graduate Graphic Design and Mandarin.

This new approach to life has had a powerful impact on Cody. Seeking to be relentlessly curious and positive, he has had opportunities to form new friendships and discover new skills that he did not realise he had.

“The friends that I have met along the way have made my study experience so much better,” says Cody.

“In Chengdu, I experienced festivals and culture. The food was one of my favourite parts, spicy and very different from the food back home. I visited traditional streets and temples, as well as the newer city. While I was there, I tried to see and do as much as I could.

“This happened because I put myself out of my comfort zone and just said yes to things that I never thought I would do.”

## **From Hamilton to Bahrain – young chef shares his secrets**

Joel Miller proves no dream is too big for an aspiring chef from Hamilton, New Zealand. Since graduating in 2016, he has been working as a chef for the royal family in Bahrain.

For as long as he can remember, Joel always wanted to be a chef. Apart from lunchtime, his food tech class was the only thing keeping him at high school.

Then in 2013 he met internationally recognised Michelin star chef Josh Emmett at his restaurant, Rātā in Queenstown.

“I was already a huge fan and couldn’t wait to get a photo for my profile picture. But I also wanted to ask what advice he had for an aspiring chef, and he said, ‘the best advice I can give you is to study cookery at Wintec, my old stomping ground in Hamilton, and then come and talk to me when you’re done’.

“In 2014, I left high school after achieving NCEA Level 1 and 2 to follow my passion for cooking and enrolled at Wintec”.

Two years later, Joel qualified as a chef and graduated with Excellence from Wintec in 2016, along with the London City and Guilds Medal of Excellence Award in Cookery. He was 18-years-old and ready to take on the world.

Conveniently, Josh Emmett opened Madam Woo in Hamilton and Joel knew he had to work there. That photo Joel took back in 2013 came in handy for the front of his CV and helped land his first dream job at the new restaurant.

Life’s opportunities can often be about who you know, and Joel’s former Wintec tutor, Amy Opperman was the link between an executive chef in Bahrain and the opportunity of a lifetime.

“The first thought I had was, where the heck is Bahrain? I had to Google the country I now live in. The ball started rolling and after a few skype interviews, a couple of months later, I packed my life into 30kg and away I went on a one-way ticket to the other side of the world.”

Moving to a country he had never heard of didn’t faze Joel, but he said arriving in Bahrain was a major culture shock.

“But when I arrived at the Palace, where I now work, it was just breath-taking! We have eight kitchens, 60 chefs, and a total of 400 staff on the grounds. I work as one of the four exclusive chefs in the International Kitchen.”

When asked what advice he would give to his younger self, Joel said: “I would tell him, you’re not going to get anywhere in life unless you put in the hard yards now. Fortunately, I think I did just that, and that hard work has got me to where I am today.

“Learn from creative people. Be a sponge,” says Joel.

## Academic Regalia

Wintec’s academic regalia dates back to the establishment of Europe’s earliest universities.

Historically, a gown and hood were practical items worn daily over tunic and trousers (usually dark coloured), and were lined in wool, fur or silk according to the season. Over the centuries the length and cut of the gown and sleeves have changed with fashion and today, are stylised rather than practical items.

The bonnet and cap are 15th century lay fashions based on the pileus, a head-dress common in the Middle Ages. The pileus quadratus (square cap) is the trencher or mortar board. Trencher is a flat board used for serving or cutting food. When turned upside down, the cap resembles a bowl on a trencher. It also looks very similar to a bricklayer’s square, flat mortar board.

Today, regalia is a symbol of academic achievement and excellence.

To wear a korowai, or cloak, is to be honoured on a special occasion and for many Māori graduands and their whānau, graduation day is one such occasion.

Traditionally the korowai is a dress cloak ornamented with black cord tags (hukahuka) and coloured borders (tāniko). Kahu huruhuru, or feather cloak, is another cloak used for special occasions.

Most korowai are made from fine, soft fibre (muka) stripped from flax leaves. This muka is hand-rolled into threads for weaving. Feathers or coloured tags are incorporated as the garment is woven.

Korowai or kahu huruhuru are treasured family items, often handed down through many generations. To wear such a treasure, or tāonga, is a great honour and privilege, enhancing the wearer’s honour and bestowing prestige on that person’s whānau and tribal groups.

In the context of the graduation ceremony, the cloak serves as an acknowledgement of the wearer’s achievements – overcoming many challenges on their journey to seek knowledge and growth.
