

# OUR FACILITIES



We have purpose-built training facilities to provide students and staff with the best possible environment to learn the skills necessary to succeed in their industries.

Since 2003, we have invested more than \$90 million upgrading our facilities, through our commitment to a campus modernisation plan. As a result we have some of the best industry training and student facilities in the country.

In 2017 we refurbished our Rotokauri student hub. The building, and its surrounds, underwent a \$3.6 million redevelopment providing larger, more vibrant, flexible and user-friendly spaces for our students, staff, partners and visitors.

In 2014 we opened our award-winning \$25 million Engineering and Trades facility at our Rotokauri campus. One of the country's most modern training facilities, the facility reflects industry standards and showcases the latest techniques and technologies. The facility also houses The Training Space, which comprises quality training rooms which local organisations use for off-site staff training.

In 2012 we opened our marae, Te Kōpū Mā ōia o Kirikirioa, on our city campus. This contemporary marae plays a role in enhancing Māori achievement by supporting our students, staff and community with their Māori education and learning.

Our refurbished heritage building Wintec House opened in 2010. Located on the corner of our Hamilton city campus this multi-purpose building has won numerous regional and national architectural awards. It is home to our flagship events venue, The Atrium, where hundreds of awards dinners, conferences and special events are held.

One of our iconic facilities is the award-winning Gallagher Hub built in 2007. It is a multi-purpose social centre with 140 computers for students to use and 24-hour student and staff access. It houses our library, flexible seating areas for meeting and socialising, a range of IT services, study rooms, cafes and event rooms.

A string of commercial and retail developments also operate on the corner of our city campus, adding to the vibrant atmosphere in the area and further enhancing our connection with the city.

Our specialist student facilities also include modern hair and beauty salons, a training restaurant, science laboratories, a veterinary surgery, a student radio station, music studios, an art gallery, childcare facility, greenhouse and practice barns and technology spaces.

Wintec has three main campuses in Hamilton, in the central city, Rotokauri (north Hamilton) and at the Hamilton Gardens.
