- Our students have 24/7 access to more than 160 high-speed internet-enabled computers at our city and Rotokauri campus hubs. We have more than 800 computers across both our campuses available for students, as well as facilities for their own devices
- Students, staff and visitors have free access to high-speed wireless internet on all of our campuses
- Our students are taught using a range of e-learning techniques such as simulation equipment, e-books and technology-enabled mobile audio-visual equipment
- Our Digital Workplace enables improved information and content sharing and is one of the main communication channels for our 900 staff
- We subscribe to a cloud-computing service provider. This allows us to have quicker access to files, offsite access, increased storage space and the ability to share documents.
