For multi-year programmes beginning 2026 (for example degrees) international tuition fees for the second and subsequent years may increase in annual tuition. There may be an independent activity fee of up to a \$1000 that may apply to certain courses which is not included in the tuition fee. These fees are approximate and are based on a full-time workload for one year. The fees may vary depending on the amount of credits you are enrolled in. The 2026 Study Grant is available to new international students enrolling in eligible programmes commencing in 2026. To be eligible, students must be enrolled in an eligible programme of at least 120 credits. The Study Grant applies to the first year of study only and is limited to one grant per student, per programme. Standard tuition fees will apply for subsequent years. All fees are in New Zealand Dollars. Fees may vary due to changes in law or regulations that are beyond the control of Wintec. Some programmes have additional costs. In some cases, New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA) fees will apply in addition to those listed. Your fees must be paid two weeks before the start of your programme, or at the time you enrol if you are enrolling within two weeks of your start date.
