Step 1: Speak with your programme manager about the possibility of doing a Student Exchange and if you can earn cross-credits with the programme you have chosen.

Step 2: Email studyabroad@wintec.ac.nz with the following:

- Name and Student ID
- University/Place of study choice
- Programme name and date you wish you go
- Programme Manager name

Step 3: We will have a meeting to discuss all questions you may have and the application process.

Step 4: Complete the application form and submit supporting documents.

Step 5: Confirm your place for Student Exchange and work with International Centre to prepare you for Student Exchange.

Step 6: Make memories overseas while you study!

Kufstein, Austria

- Area: 39.37 km²
- Population: 20,212

Today Kufstein is the largest town in the District of Kufstein and the second largest after Innsbruck in the Province of the Tyrol. The town of Kufstein lies at about 503 meters above sea level. The alpine climate means cold, snowy winters and relatively warm summers. Temperatures range from -5°C in winter up to 30 °C in summer.

German is the official language but English is by far the leading foreign language and is widely spoken and understood.

The University

FH Kufstein Tirol University of Applied Sciences is a public, university-level post-secondary education institution owned by the Kufstein University of Applied Sciences, and was founded in 1997. There are currently 2200 students studying in 14 bachelor programmes, 14 master programmes and several post graduate courses. Around 200 international students enrich the campus with an international flair.

On May 9, 2012, the Kufstein University of Applied Sciences and all its degree programs were awarded full accreditation by the Agency for Quality Assurance and Accreditation Austria (AQ Austria) in accordance with §23 of the Act on Quality Assurance in Higher Education (HS-QSG). With this accreditation, the Kufstein University of Applied Sciences is now officially one of Austria's institutions of higher education that has been positively assessed and was awarded this accreditation unconditionally.

Study

The FH Kufstein offers its exchange students a special International Programme (IP). The IP is open to all students from their partner universities just as their partner institutions welcome the students from the FH Kufstein when they do their compulsory study-abroad semester. The IP offers a range of courses, all of them held exclusively in English.

In order to give the incoming exchange students some insights into Austrian history and culture, the International Relations Office (IRO) regularly offers courses such as "Austrian Culture & History" and "German Language". These courses are a great stepping stone for our guests on their way to exploring Kufstein, its surroundings, and the rest of Austria.

Exchange students can expect to receive from the IRO comprehensive support and consultation in all matters concerning the International Program and their stay in Austria.

International Student Support

- ESN (Erasmus Student Network) organizes social gatherings and helps the International students to settle in Kufstein and integrate in Austrian society.
- Every exchange student has his/her own buddy to help with settling in
