STEP 3: We will have a meeting to discuss all questions you may have and the application process


STEP 4: Confirm your place for Student Exchange and work with International Centre to prepare you for Student Exchange



Dunkirk is a coastal city in northern France. About a 2 hour train ride south to Paris. This town has a thick war history. Temperature varies a great deal across the seasons with a mild spring, warmer summer months, frequently rainy and windy autumn months and cooler winter months, often with frost and occasional snow. Temperatures range from 2°C in winter up to 20 °C in summer.

French is the official language but English is widely spoken and understood.
