If you are a 2nd year student or higher in a degree programme within **Centre for Business and Enterprise** you can do a student exchange with Kozminski University. There are multiple modules to select from that may fit right into your learning pathway.

HOW TO APPLY

STEP 1: Speak with your programme manager about the possibility of doing a Student Exchange and if you can earn cross-credits with the programme you have chosen

STEP 2: Email **studyabroad@wintec.ac.nz** with the following:

- Name and Student ID
- University/Place of study choice
- Programme Name and date you wish you go
- Programme Manager name

STEP 3: We will have a meeting to discuss all questions you may have and the application process

STEP 4: Confirm your place for Student Exchange and work with International Centre to prepare you for Student Exchange

Key Facts

Warsaw, Poland

- Area: 91 km²
- Population: 336,411



Warsaw is notable among Europe's capital cities not for its size, its age, or its beauty but for its indestructibility. It is a phoenix that has risen repeatedly from the ashes of war.

The climate is moderate and rather cool, the prevailing westerly winds bringing frequent changes of weather. The average yearly temperature is about 8 °C, with a July average of about 19 °C and a January average of about -3 °C. Yearly rainfall averages 21 inches (541mm), most of which falls in the summer. Snow cover persists for 50 to 64 days a year.

Polish is the official language but English is common in the city.

The University

Kozminski University, founded in 1993, is a private institution of higher education with full academic rights. The university has obtained Polish and international accreditations, as well as excellent results in global and national educational rankings which shows the high quality of its programs and services.

Kozminski University holds three international accreditations: EQUIS, AMBA and AACSB. Only around 70 business schools from all over the world hold all three accreditations. The AACSB accreditation is awarded to such prestigious universities such as Yale and Harvard.

Study

Kozminski's 3.4 hectare campus consists of four buildings (A, B, C and D) with a total area of approximately 20,000 square meters. The school has 6 large auditoriums (each seating between 100 and 200 people) as well as 26 classrooms (seating 50 to 100 people) and 24 workshop classrooms (seating up to 50 people).

The school owns 5 seminar and discussion group rooms, as well as a Senate Hall (seating 120 people), 4 computer labs and 2 server rooms. The 3 cafeterias are available for faculty and students and are located on the premises as well as a bookstore, 2 photocopying offices, 5 coffee machines, a cash machine, a post office, 5 student organization offices and 3 guest apartments for visiting faculty members. Furthermore, there are 98 fully equipped faculty and administration offices.
