

Innsbruck, capital of Austria's western state of Tyrol, is a city in the Alps that's long been a destination for winter sports. Innsbruck is also known for its Imperial and modern architecture. The Nordkette funicular (a gondola), climbs up to 2,256m from the city center for skiing in winter and hiking or mountaineering in warmer months. Temperatures range from -10°C in winter up to 25 °C in summer.

Austrian German is the official language but English is widely spoken and understood.

The University
