How to apply

Step 1: Speak with your programme manager about the possibility of doing a Student Exchange and if you can earn cross-credits with the programme you have chosen.

Step 2: Email studyabroad@wintec.ac.nz with the following:

- Name and Student ID
- University/Place of study choice
- Programme name and date you wish you go
- Programme Manager name

Step 3: We will have a meeting to discuss all questions you may have and the application process.

Step 4: Complete the application form and submit supporting documents.

Step 5: Confirm your place for Student Exchange and work with International Centre to prepare you for Student Exchange.

Innsbruck, capital of Austria's western state of Tyrol, is a city in the Alps that's long been a destination for winter sports. Innsbruck is also known for its Imperial and modern architecture. The Nordkette funicular (a gondola), climbs up to 2,256m from the city center for skiing in winter and hiking or mountaineering in warmer months. Temperatures range from -10°C in winter up to 30°C in summer.

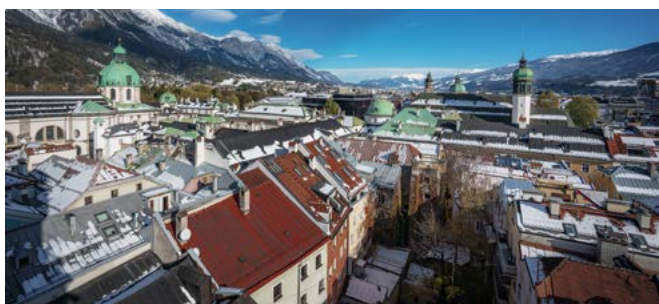
German is the official language but English is widely spoken and understood.

The University

Internationalisation is one of the salient pillars of MCI. Its international orientation is mirrored in its diverse student and staff population; numerous partner universities; international curriculum at undergraduate and post-graduate level; international projects and research and international accreditation such as AACSB, FIBAA.

MCI has around 3,627 students of which 50% are international students. In addition, around 847 incoming students from our 300 partner universities join MCI every year. A number that is significantly increasing, and speaks volumes.



Study

MCI offers bachelor's and master's courses as well as postgraduate training programs. The course contents target all levels of personal development and include state-of-the-art knowledge relevant to business, engineering and society. Quality teaching with focus on theory and practice; small groups of students; interactive teaching and learning as well as international student and staff population predominantly constitute its academic strengths.
