HOW TO APPLY

STEP 1: Speak with your programme manager about the possibility of doing a Student Exchange and if you can earn cross-credits with the programme you have chosen

STEP 2: Email **studyabroad@wintec.ac.nz** with the following:

- Name and Student ID
- University/Place of study choice
- Programme Name/Modules and date you wish to go
- Programme Manager name

STEP 3: We will have a meeting to discuss all questions you may have and the application process

STEP 4: Confirm your place for Student Exchange and work with International Centre to prepare you for Student Exchange

STEP 5: Make memories overseas while you study!

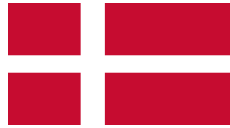

Key Facts

Aarhus, Denmark



- Area: 91 km²
- Population: 336,411

Aarhus is the second largest city in Denmark. Located on the east coast of the Jutland Peninsula. This town was originally a Viking settlement and boasts an incredible history to discover. Temperature varies a great deal across the seasons with a mild spring, warmer summer months, frequently rainy and windy autumn months and cooler winter months, often with frost and occasional snow. Temperatures range from 0°C in winter up to 25 °C in summer.

Danish is the official language but English is widely spoken and understood.
