How to apply

Step 1: Speak with your Programme Coordinator or Team Manager about the possibility of doing a Student Exchange and if you can earn cross-credits with the programme you have chosen.

Step 2: Email <u>studyabroad@wintec.ac.nz</u> with the following:


- · Name and Student ID

Area: 91 km2Population: 352,315



Aarhus is the second largest city in Denmark. Located on the est coast of the Jutland Peninsula. This town was originally a Viking settlement and boast an incredible history to discover. Temperature varies a great deal across the seasons with a mild spring, warmer summer months, frequently rainy and windy autumn months and cooler winter months, often with frost and occasional snow. Temperatures range from 0°C in winter up to 25 °C in summer.

Danish is the official language but English is widely spoken and understood.
