STUDENTS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST LIVE IN WINTEC APPROVED ACCOMMODATION.

Option 1: HOMESTAY

Placements are for a minimum of 4 weeks, after which you pay your host directly.

Option 2: STUDENT VILLAGE

Placements are for a minimum of 1 semester (21 weeks).

Option 3: DESIGNATED CAREGIVER

This option allows you to live with a relative or close family friend, designated in writing by your parent or legal guardian. Caregivers must apply and be approved by Wintec.

 The placement fee covers the caregiver application processing, administration cost and the police vetting fees. If the application is approved, the student can live with their designated caregiver while studying at Wintec If the application is declined, the application can be transferred to a homestay or Student Village application, and at no additional cost 	\$350
