1. Admission and Entry

1.1 Open Entry if the delegated authority at the campus/site is satisfied that the applicant has the capability to complete the requirements of the programme.

1.2 English Language Requirements

Candidates who have English as a second language are required to have an International English Language Test System (IELTS) score of 5 in the academic band, with no individual band score lower than 5; or equivalent.

2. Transfer of Credit

2.1 100% transfer of credit is available for this programme (both formal transfer of credit and recognition of prior learning).

3. Programme Requirements

3.1 Every candidate for the New Zealand Certificate in Animal Care (Level 3) shall to the satisfaction of the Academic Board follow a programme of study for a period of normally not less than one semester.

3.2 Each candidate's programme will comprise all modules as listed in Section 6 of these regulations, totaling a minimum of 70 credits.

4. Completion of the Programme

4.1 A candidate may take up to four years to complete this programme, unless an extension is granted by special permission of the Group Director, or designated equivalent.

5. Award of the Qualification

5.1 Candidates who successfully complete the requirements of this programme will be eligible for the award of the New Zealand Certificate in Animal Care (Level 3) with strand in Companion Animals.
