1. Admission and Entry

General Admission

- a) Candidates must be 16 years or older.
- b) Candidates must have achieved NZCEL (General) (Level 3); or
- c) Have achieved an overall IELTS score of 5.0 with no individual band score lower than 4.5, or
- d) Candidates must take part in a selection interview and will be required to take a placement test to determine their current English Language level and learning goals.

1.2 **Selection Criteria**

Candidates must demonstrate a reasonable chance of success in the programme.

Transfer of Credit 2.

100% transfer of credit is available for this programme (both formal transfer of credit and recognition of prior learning).

3. **Programme Requirements**

Every candidate for the New Zealand Certificate in English Language (Applied) (Level 3) shall to the satisfaction of the Academic Board follow a programme of study for a period of normally not less than one semester.

Candidates for the New Zealand Certificate in English Language (Applied) (Level 3)enrolled in the Applied Academic context are required to successfully complete the compulsory modules listed in Group A in section 6.1 totalling a minimum of 60 credits.

Candidates for the New Zealand Certificate in English Language (Applied) (Level 3)enrolled in the Applied Employment context are required to successfully complete the compulsory modules listed in Group B in section 6.1 totalling a minimum of 60 credits.

4. Completion of the Programme


A candidate may take up to one year to complete this programme, unless an extension is granted by special permission of the Centre Director, or designated equivalent.
