# **MEETING VENUE**

**Rotokauri Campus:** S Block (The Rotokauri Hub) for all STAR courses taught at this campus. Look for the dark green and white STAR sign near the information desk.

**City Campus:** Gallagher Hub (building with the café, library, and other student services). Look for the dark green and white STAR sign on one of the shared tables.

**Hamilton Gardens Campus:** Access via the public car park at Gate 2. Cross the bridge from the car park, over to the Horticulture Education Centre reception.

At the meet and greet session, students will be required to complete an enrolment form before begining their course.

# **CAR PARKING**

**Rotokauri Campus:** Students are required to 'pay & display'. Students can park in car park 1 or 2, but students cannot park in visitor parking as this will incur a parking infringement. Parking costs \$1 per hour, capped at \$6 per day, between 8am and 4pm weekdays. Tickets can be purchased from payment machines located in the car parks.

**Hamilton Gardens:** Free parking is available at the Hamilton Gardens Campus in the public car park.

**City Campus:** There is no parking available at the City Campus.
