### ***General Academic Admission***

There is open entry to this programme although students must demonstrate a reasonable likelihood of success.

### ***Selection Criteria***

- Applicants are accepted into the programme in the order their applications are received.
- An interview process will be available on application to determine whether any specific support is required and to ensure students are well informed about the programme.

### ***English Language Requirements***

Candidates who have English as a second language are required to have an International English Language Test System (IELTS) score of 5.5, with no individual band score lower than 5; or equivalent.

### ***Transfer of Credit***

100% transfer of credit is available for this programme (both formal transfer of credit and recognition of prior learning).

### ***Programme Requirements***

- Every candidate for the Certificate in Baking programme shall to the satisfaction of the Academic Board follow a programme of study for a period of normally not less than one semester.
- Each candidate's programme will comprise all modules as listed in Section 6 of these regulations, totalling 60 credits.

### ***Completion of the Programme***

A candidate may take up to one year to complete this programme, unless an extension is granted by special permission of the Centre Director, or designated equivalent.
