These regulations take effect from January 2020 and should be read in conjunction with the Institute's Academic Regulations.

1. Admission and Entry

- 1.1 Subject to the requirements specified in clause 1.2 of these regulations, there is open entry to this programme.
- 1.2 As part of the selection process candidates may be required to attend an interview.
- 1.3 Candidates who have English as a second language are required to have an International English Language Test System (IELTS) score of 5.0, with no individual band score lower than 5.0; or equivalent.

2. Programme Requirements

Candidates for the Outdoor Experience Level 2 Training Scheme will be enrolled in modules detailed in the Schedule of Modules (section 5 of these specifications). Candidates must successfully complete the listed modules to meet the requirements of the qualification.

3. Completion of the Programme

A candidate may take up to one year to complete this programme, unless an extension is granted by special permission of the Centre Director, or designated equivalent.

4. Award of the Qualification

Candidates who successfully complete the requirements of this programme will be eligible for the award of Outdoor Experience Level 2.
